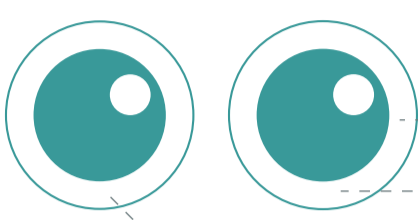

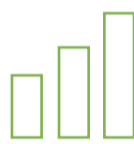


CAN CAUSE:

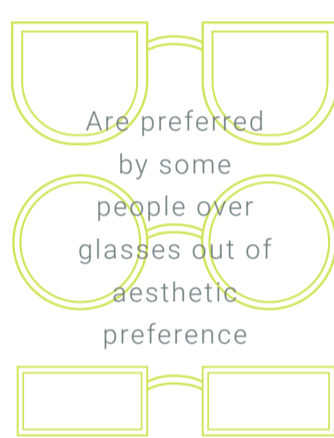
- Infections

Must be purchased regularly over the course of a lifetime - an annual average of

Studies show that risk of vision-threatening infections is higher with contact wear versus patients undergoing LASIK surgery.



Contacts conform to the curvature of your eye, providing a wider field of view and causing less vision distortions and obstructions than eyeglasses



Complications occur over a period of years and can be hard or impossible to correct

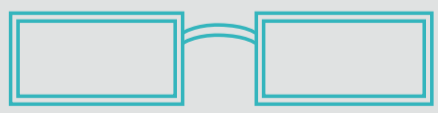

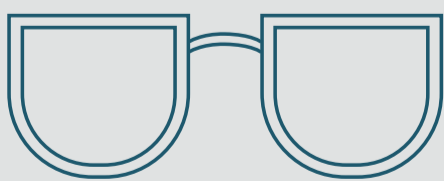
 = \$2,100

One-time purchase of \$2,100 per eye, on average

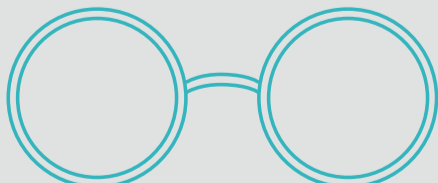
Don't have the hassle of **REMEMBERING** to put contacts in and take them out

Over 90% of patients no longer require glasses for driving.

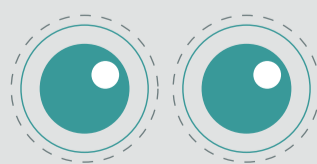
